Some information for presenters and discussants

- 1) Presenters have 25 minutes, the two discussants a total of 25 minutes and there is going to be 10 minutes of general discussion for each paper. Please try to maintain the time limit since there are many papers in the program and the risks of overflow substantial.
- 2) Papers have to be sent by March 15 in pdf format to Anna Ricart at CREI (<a href="mailto:anna.ricart@upf.edu">anna.ricart@upf.edu</a>). Please make sure that the deadline is met since March 21 is Easter and all copying facilities will shut down for at least 5 days at UPF. Conference paper will be posted at the CREI site.
- 3) Discussants are responsible for making sure that the authors give them the papers on time for them to do their job. A reasonable deadline is March 15, but individual agreements between authors and discussants are welcome. Some discussant asked to see very preliminary versions of the works to get an idea what the papers are about. At least a detailed abstract should be given if requested.
- 4) To avoid to loose time at the beginning of each presentation, it is advisable that authors and discussants send their files at least a few days in advance in order to load them in the computer. Presentation and discussions should be in \*.ppt or \*.pdf (or comparable) formats, since these are the only two supported by the computer in the presentation room. A traditional overhead projector will also be available for those who want to use it.. It would also help if you send your presentation a few days in advance so that it can be directly uploaded in the conference room computer by the guys at the Computer Center at UPF.
