On behalf of the Centre de Recerca en Economia Internacional (CREI) and the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR), we invite you to submit a paper for a workshop on the interplay between institutions and international capital flows. The workshop will be hosted by CREI and funded by the European Research Council through the Starting Grant Agreement 241114 "Institutions and Globalization". It will take place in Barcelona, at the campus of the Universitat Pompeu Fabra.

Topics of particular interest for submissions include:

- Political, legal and financial determinants of international capital flows
- International capital flows, risk taking and financial fragility
- International capital flows and institutional reforms
- Financial Regulation and financial openness

We will accept around 8 papers for presentation in the workshop. Presentations will start on Monday morning at lunchtime and finish on Tuesday afternoon, leaving ample opportunity for discussion among the participants. Travel and accommodation expenses will be reimbursed according to CEPR guidelines.
