**Changes in Labor Market Dynamics**

On behalf of the Centre de Recerca en Economia Internacional (CREI) and the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR), we invite you to submit a paper for a workshop on changes in labor market dynamics. The workshop will be hosted by CREI and funded by the European Research Council through the Advanced Grant “Labor Markets, Economic Fluctuations and Monetary Policy”. It will take place in Barcelona, at the campus of the Universitat Pompeu Fabra.

Suitable research questions for submissions include (but are not limited to):

- How do the dynamics of labor market variables vary across countries and what explains these differences?
- How have labor market dynamics changed over time, e.g. with the recent financial crisis?
- How have changes in business cycle dynamics, e.g. the Great Moderation, affected the labor market?
- How have changes in labor market institutions affected business cycle dynamics?
- How do changing labor market institutions affect the welfare costs of fluctuations?

We will accept around 8 papers for presentation in the workshop. Presentations will start on Friday afternoon and finish at lunch time on Saturday, leaving ample opportunity for discussion among the participants. Travel and accommodation expenses will be reimbursed according to CEPR guidelines.

The deadline for submissions is Sunday, May 2, 2010. Papers submitted after this date or on topics outside the scope of the workshop will not be considered.
