### **XV Workshop in International Economics and Finance**

The XV Workshop in International Economics and Finance, organized by the Centre de Recerca en Economia Internacional (CREI), Universidad Torcuato Di Tella, the World Bank LAC Chief Economist Office, the InterAmerican Development Bank (IDB), and the Centre for Economic Policy Research (CEPR) will take place in Barcelona, Spain, at the campus of Universitat Pompeu Fabra, on July 2 and 3, 2012.

This workshop brings together top researchers from the North and the South to discuss recent theoretical and empirical advances in International Economics and Finance. The goal of these meetings is to gain a better understanding of the macroeconomic problems faced by emerging markets and to encourage research on the subject.
