TRADE, GROWTH AND INCOME DISTRIBUTION

This workshop, jointly organized by the Barcelona GSE and the Centre de Recerca en Economia Internacional (CREI), aims to gather researchers working on the causes and consequences of growth in the global economy to discuss recent advances on issues related to the interplay of technological change, international trade and political economy, and their relationship to economic growth and income differences.

Topics of interest include:

- The interaction between trade, technological progress and growth
- Effects of trade and growth on income distribution, both within and between countries
- The effects of technological change and trade on the global organization of production
- Challenges to policymaking in an integrated world
- The political economy of trade, growth and development

The workshop will take place on June, 12-13 in Barcelona.

The **deadline for submissions** is February 15th 2013. To submit a paper, use this [FORM](#). Authors chosen to present papers will be notified by February 28th. A preliminary program will be announced by March 14th.
