INTERNATIONAL CAPITAL FLOWS

This workshop, jointly organized by the Barcelona GSE and the Centre de Recerca en Econoia Internacional (CREI) aims to discuss recent theoretical and empirical advances in the study of international capital flows. We welcome papers on International Economics, Macroeconomics and Finance related to the following topics:

- Financial crises and capital flows
- Sovereign debt crises
- Capital flows, risk taking and financial fragility
- Monetary policy and capital flows
- Effects of capital controls
- Credit markets and economic activity in the open economy
- Interaction of public and private capital flows

The workshop will take place on June, 19-20 in Barcelona.

The **deadline for submissions** is February 15th 2013. To submit a paper use this [FORM](#). Authors chosen to present papers will be notified by March 7th. A preliminary program will be announced by March 22nd.

The Barcelona GSE will be able to cover travel and accommodation expenses for speakers, with some limits agreed in advance.
