TRADE, GROWTH AND INCOME DISTRIBUTION

This workshop, jointly organized by the Barcelona GSE and Centre de Recerca en Economia Internacional (CREI), is focused on the interplay between technological change, international trade and political economy, and their relationship to economic growth and income differences.

Topics of interest include:

- The interaction between trade, technological progress and growth
- Effects of trade and growth on income distribution, both within and between countries
- The effects of technological change and trade on the global organization of production
- Challenges to policymaking in an integrated world
- The political economy of trade, growth and development

The workshop, featuring Elhanan Helpman (Harvard University) as invited speaker, will take place on **June, 8-9, 2015** in Barcelona.

The **deadline for submissions** is January 31, 2015. To submit a paper, please use this [LINK](#). Submissions should include either a full paper or an extended abstract with the main results. Authors of accepted papers will be notified approximately by February, 2015. A preliminary program will be announced by March 1, 2015.
