## MONETARY POLICY AND CENTRAL BANKING

The workshop will run for 2 days and will take place on June 13-14, 2019 in Barcelona.

The purpose of the workshop is to discuss a selected number of research papers focusing on the study of monetary policy and other central bank policies. Suitable topics include (but are not restricted to):

- The role played by agents' heterogeneity and financial frictions
- · The challenges imposed by a zero lower bound on interest rates
- International dimensions of central bank policies
- The role of central bank communication
- The design of monetary policies
- Central banks' decision-making

The **deadline for submissions** is **February 28, 2019**. To submit a paper, please use this link <u>https://app-summerforum.barcelonagse.eu</u>. Submissions should include either a full paper or an extended abstract with the main results. Please also indicate (in the comments section) if you would be interested in presenting in a poster session.

Authors chosen to present papers will be notified approximately by mid-March. A preliminary program will be announced by mid-April.

When you submit your paper, you will be able to see the topics and dates of other workshops that will take place within the Summer Forum. **The same paper cannot be submitted to more than one workshop, but you are welcome to submit a different paper to another workshop.**
